


The City of Laurel aspires to have 15 acres of parkland per 1000 people



The City of Laurel Subdivision Regulations requires that "in every instance of subdivision approval for residential use the Planning Commission shall require every subdivider who subdivides land to dedicate to the City of Laurel a portion of such land, pay a fee, or do both for the purpose of providing park and recreational facilities to serve future residents of such subdivisions."
